The student is examined through written preparation for **(2 credits)** and active participation in seminars and workshops **(1.5 credits)**, and through written documentation **(3.5 credits)** and oral presentation **(0.5 credit)** of a project.

Written Preparation Before Seminars

Each week a seminar preparation instruction will be posted. Each seminar preparation will connect to themes associated with the seminar to be held, which in turn is connected to lectures and literature. These preparation tasks will be posted on Studentportalen after class and are to be completed by the next seminar. The content submitted will inform a large part of the related seminar.

Some seminar preparation tasks will be individual and some will be in group. The nature of the tasks will vary, but they will employ a range of critical and creative thinking faculties.

All written preparation tasks should be completed as part of the examination requirement.

Active Participation in Seminars

Two seminars will focus specifically on literature and critically reflecting on the course themes to date.

These two seminars are mandatory. If you miss one or both of these mandatory sessions there will be a ReSeminar held on Wednesday 20th May 2020, 17:15-20:00.

<u>3.5 credits - [F,3,4,5]</u>

Written Documentation of Project work consisting of the following

- A portfolio of materials documenting your design process. Due May 27th 2019, 17:00. The portfolio will be graded Pass/Fail.
- 2. Two critical reflections in academic essay form. Due March 4th 2019, 17:00 & April 29th 17:00 respectively

Each critical reflection will be graded Fail/3/4/5

Oral Presentation of Project work

There will be a presentation session during class time on **May 27th, 2019**. This will involve presentation of the project you have worked on as part of the portfolio.

There is a deadline for all outstanding work on Friday June 5th 2019, 17:00.
