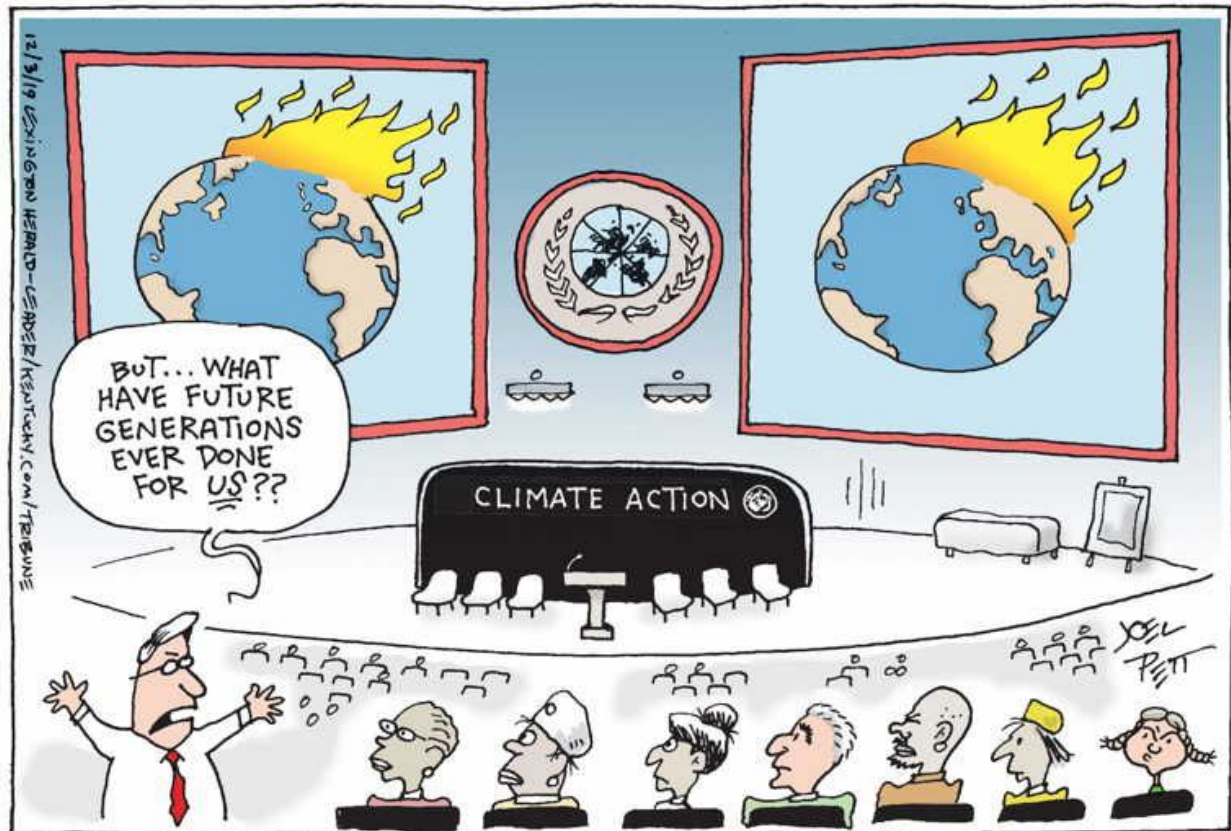

Examination, literature and course structure

*The student is examined through **written preparation for (4 credits) and active participation in seminars and workshops (3 credits)**, and through **written documentation (7 credits) and oral presentation (1 credit) of a project.***

The course is worth 15 credits (ECTS) and is thus given at 50% of a full-time study workload, which equals around 20 hours per week. Classes run weekly on Mondays and Wednesdays from 13:15 to 16:00. **All classes are planned to be held online via Zoom due to the Covid-19 pandemic.**

Climate Change Leadership 2021 uses **mandatory course books** and additional learning materials provided on Studium, including texts, podcasts and videos.
