## **Course information**

The course is worth 15 credits (ECTS) and is given at 50% of a full-time study workload, which equals to 20 hours per week. Class is most often two afternoons per week, Tuesday and Thursday, for the entire spring semester. The first class session is January 19th and the final session takes place on June 3rd. The semester at CEMUS also starts with an opening lecture on January 18th with Sachico Ishihara and Cristian Alarcon which we encourage you to attend!
